<u>Towards a Synodal Church – The Global Synod 2021–24</u>

In an address in Rome on 17 October 2015, Pope Francis proclaimed that "It is precisely this path of synodality which God expects of the Church of the third millennium". Over the intervening years, the shift from the old to the new – from a hierarchical to a synodal Church – has progressively gathered momentum.

Globally, the 2021–24 Synod – 'For a Synodal Church' – is emerging as the most significant gathering for the Church since the Second Vatican Council 60 years ago. An extensive consultation process has been undertaken, covering all regions of the world and many levels of the Church. Drawing on that feedback, an impressive *Instrumentum Laboris* (Working Document) has been published (see <u>https://www.synod.va/en.html</u>).
